Formative Assessments include the objectives below and are 50% of the student's total grade.

Students will be asked to perform specific scales and rudiments from memory during class. Students will have one (1) chance to perform the scale/rudiment. An "error" is defined as a wrong note, a severely out of tune note, a disturbance of the time and/or rhythm, or incorrect sticking. Each error is worth five (5) points and the errors will be tallied at the end of the performance and deducted from 100 for the scale grade. Scales not performed the correct number of octaves as per the mid-state range requirements will be handled at the director's discretion. Students will be allowed one (1) retake for any scale/rudiment (before school, C&I, after school) and whichever grade is the highest will be the grade that will be assigned. Any and all retakes must occur before the end of school on Friday, 9/21/18.

A short music excerpt will be performed in class and will serve as a chair placement audition. This excerpt will be graded by the individual performance rubric. Students are expected to prepare this piece outside of class. This assignment may not be made-up. **The audition will take place on Monday, August 20.**

Grading scale for Music Worksheets: The grade you earn is the grade you receive. If a student chooses to retake a worksheet, ONE re-take is allowed. The higher score will be the grade.

Students are expected to come to class prepared. This means having your instrument and all necessary equipment for the rehearsal (sticks/mallets, pad/stand, etc.). Students are expected to have ALL assigned equipment set up by 8:30 and any additional materials needed (folder, Foundations Book, warm-up exercises, concert music, etc.) and a pencil. Students are also expected to return ALL equipment to its assigned location at the end of class. Failure to do so will result in a deduction of 2 points per missing item or infraction. Students should be rehearsal ready and focused throughout the rehearsal. Any disruptions (talking or otherwise) will result in a deduction from the participation grade. This will be at the discretion of the directors.
