2.	6:02 Michele- we have received payments for four events. \$4588.50. Two events have not yet been received. She will be speaking tonight about getting volunteers at the booster meeting. There is one concert coming up. There should be soccer events in the spring.
3.	<p>6:04 Lisa spoke about concert attire. She spoke with a representative from the company and the dress is just a sample for sizing purposes only. The one will order will be short sleeves and the neckline is higher. Sizes we can get will be 0-28. We have enough sizes for the girls to try on. We also have the blouses and a pair of pants. Mrs. Monson said they want to steer the girls toward the blouse and pants. The dresses will be floor length. We need to get the girls sized and ordered the it will go straight into production within 10 days. This way we can get the dresses back in time for the Christmas concert. Joey will ask boosters for \$3500.00 for shed and &10,000.00 for the Mule.
